Under low maintenance conditions, Isabel has demonstrated good response to drought stress.

### PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

For ideal turf, plant Isabel on fertile, neutral pH soils during the cooler seasons of the year, such as spring and fall. If needing to plant during other times, plan on additional overseeding.

For a thick, lush turf, seed at these rates:

Seeding Rate in lbs./1000 sq. ft.

New Lawns: 3-4; Existing Lawns: 1-3
