



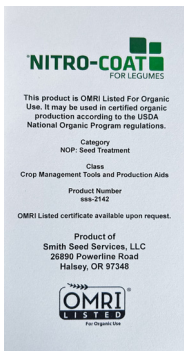
Calm Before The Storm
